

## **« EduBoard » and how to better keep track of your school progression**

The Ministry of national Education, Children and Youth has launched a new application for VET pupils. « EduBoard » is a dashboard allowing pupils from VET to keep track online of their training path and individual school progression.

With « eduBoard » pupils can check at any moment how many modules they have to pass during their training, how many modules they have already passed and how many they still have to pass in order to successfully finish the different steps of their school path (annual progression, intermediary report, final report, ...). The information available on « eduBoard » is updated biannually, at the end of the class council.

The access to « eduBoard » is strictly personal and secured with the identity and access management system IAM put in place by the Centre of IT management (Centre de gestion informatique de l'éducation, (CGIE)) of the Ministry of National Education, Children and Youth.

The platform comes in addition to the 154 explanatory sheets of the VET trainings that are offered in the Luxembourgish school system. It thus completes the information device necessary for pupils' orientation and helps them to have an overview of their individual progression.
